Settling in: first 48 hours

Keep your puppy's new world small, quiet and predictable.

- ✓ **Rest comes first.** Set up one quiet corner with a bed or crate, and keep visitors to a minimum.
- ✓ **Water before food.** Offer small amounts of water first; after 1-2 hours of settling, offer a small meal of the familiar food.
- ✓ **The first night may be noisy.** Separation is new. Reassure calmly, check toilet needs and keep night waking quiet.
- ✓ **No bath during the first week.** Let your puppy settle first; use pet-safe wipes for small areas if needed.
- ✓ **Observe the whole puppy.** Note eating, drinking, toileting, stools, sleep and energy. Record anything unusual.

Book a new-puppy health check within 48-72 hours. Take this booklet and the supplied health records.

Avoid high-risk public areas until the full puppy vaccination course is complete. Boarding kennels and day care services commonly require C5 vaccination.

When to see a vet

Puppies can deteriorate quickly. Treat these signs as urgent.

Red flags

- Repeated vomiting
- Diarrhoea with blood
- Marked lethargy or refusing food and water for more than 12-24 hours
- Rapid or difficult breathing
- Seizure, collapse or severe weakness

Check that every digit above matches your veterinary and council paperwork before submitting forms.

Change of ownership

The microchip only helps reunite you with your puppy when the database contact details are correct.

1

Kennel starts the transfer

FluffyWA submits or initiates the ownership transfer with the microchip database.

2

Confirm the database email

When the registry email arrives, confirm the transfer and carefully check your contact details.

3

Keep details current

Update the registry promptly whenever you move or change your phone number.

CAR change of ownership is free or low cost. Current forms, fees and processes are set by the registry, so always check the official database website.

Under the WA **Dog Act 1976**, your puppy must be microchipped and registered with the local council before reaching 3 months of age.

Standard fees in Dog Regulations 2013

Check your council

Dog status	1 year	3 years	Lifetime
Sterilised	\$20	\$42.50	\$100
Unsterilised	\$50	\$120	\$250

Pension card holders pay half price. Registration usually requires the microchip number and proof of sterilisation. Always confirm the current rate on your council website.

1 Find your council

Use the local government for your home address.

2 Submit the registration

Apply online or at the council counter with the requested documents.

3 Collect the dog tag

Keep the issued council tag on your dog's collar.

Desexing & registration savings

Choose the timing for the individual dog, not by the calendar alone.

Discuss timing with your vet

For large dogs, 12-18 months is a common discussion window. Your veterinarian should individualise the plan.

Keep the certificate

Store it with this booklet. Your council will usually request proof when applying for the reduced registration rate.

Rates and processes can change. Confirm current requirements with your council before applying.

Puppies are more exposed to accidents and illness while they explore, and veterinary treatment can be costly.

Insurance can help you plan for eligible unexpected costs. Compare the policy wording, not just the headline.

What to compare

- ✓ Waiting periods before cover starts
- ✓ Pre-existing condition exclusions
- ✓ Annual benefit limits
- ✓ Reimbursement percentage
- ✓ How premiums may change each year

Grooming & coat care

- ✓ **Brush thoroughly every week.** For double coats, line-brush in small rows all the way to the skin; brush more often during coat blow.
- ✓ **Never shave a double coat.** It provides insulation and sun protection; only a veterinarian should direct medical clipping.
- ✓ **Dry wet coats to the skin.** Trapped moisture under a dense coat can contribute to irritation and hot spots.
- ✓ **Start handling practice early.** Pair brief touching, brushing and distant dryer sounds with treats, then build up gradually.

Training & socialising

Weeks 3–16 are a key socialisation window: focus on safe, positive quality.

- ✓ **Socialise safely before full vaccination.** Use carried outings and controlled visits at friends' homes; avoid unknown dogs and high-risk public ground.
- ✓ **Train little and often.** Keep sessions positive and brief—about 1–3 minutes—then stop while the puppy is succeeding.
- ✓ **Start with three useful skills.** Reward sit, come and toileting in the chosen spot. Make the next step easier after a mistake.

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Boarding & daycare

Plan early so your dog can meet the people and place before the stay.

- ✓ **Book ahead for travel and busy periods.** Share routines, medication and emergency contacts when booking.
- ✓ **Keep the C5 certificate ready.** Boarding and daycare services commonly require a current C5 vaccination; see chapter 7.
- ✓ **Meet before the first stay.** A Trial Meet & Greet helps your dog become familiar with the environment and team.

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Are soft stools normal during the first two days?

Mild stress-related soft stools can occur for 1-2 days. Keep the familiar food and observe; seek veterinary care if your puppy refuses water, worsens or has blood in the stool.

When can my puppy go to the park?

Wait about two weeks after the final puppy vaccination before unrestricted public-ground outings, unless your vet advises otherwise.

What should I do about crying at night?

Reassure calmly, check toilet needs and never punish. It is normal during separation and usually improves over the first few nights.

When should I change to adult dog food?

Around 12 months is common; large dogs may change later. Follow your veterinarian's advice.

When should I buy pet insurance?

As early as practical, ideally before waiting periods delay cover. Compare the policy wording and see chapter 14.

How often does my puppy need worming?

Frequency changes with age. Follow the completed record and future schedule in chapter 6, using the current weight and product directions.
